Once trained and certified, Mental Health "First Aiders" will be able to:

- Identify and respond to signs and symptoms of a mental health or substance use challenge
- Apply a 5-step Action Plan to recognize warning signs of depression; anxiety; suicidal thoughts; nonsuicidal self-injury; and, psychotic, substance use and eating disorders
- Distinguish between crisis and non-crisis situations when providing aid and calling or making referrals to appropriate support and services
